

Stop-N-Go of Madison, Inc. Milwaukee Brewers Baseball Sweepstakes- Official Rules

- 4. Prizes/Approximate Retail Value ("ARV") in U.S. Dollars. One (1) Grand Prize** consisting of 4 Milwaukee Brewers Baseball Johnsonville Party Deck Tickets (ARV: \$208.00). TOTAL ARV of all prizes is \$208.00
